

Proclaim '15 - A National Evangelisation Initiative

Cardinal Vincent Nichols, Archbishop of Westminster, introduced this key evangelisation initiative to the Diocese.

A project of the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales, it is designed to affirm the good work that is already being done by the Catholic community, and to provide resources and events to profile and develop new expressions of Catholic joy and missionary outreach. It is inspired by Pope Francis' writings.



"This pioneering initiative, inspired by Pope Francis' *Evangelii Gaudium*, is for all clergy, religious and lay people. Why? Because we all share the one mission –

to PROCLAIM the joy of the Gospel.

"The parish is the presence of the Church in given territory, an environment for hearing God's word, for growth in the Christian life, for dialogue, proclamation, charitable outreach, worship and celebration. We must admit, though, that the call to review and renew our parishes has not yet sufficed to bring them nearer to people, to make them environments of living communion and participation, and to make them completely mission-oriented."

What can we do in our Parish?

Some parishioners gathered together with Father John (you will probably have seen the invitations to attend the meetings in the parish newsletter) and took the decision to focus on the following three areas:

- 1. To deepen further our prayer life through looking at the variety of opportunities for prayer available and endeavouring to extend these.
- 2. To extend and develop the social action work in our parish.
- 3. To endeavour to deepen the sense of belonging of non-churchgoing Catholics in our parish.
