

Faith Sharing for Autumn 2017

The Diocese of Westminster gives priority to the support and promotion of small faith-sharing groups. Such groups meet to share the Bible, share their experience and discuss their meaning for the wider community, often undertaking common projects in response to local needs.

The Agency for Evangelisation works to support existing communities through the production of the exploring faith resources and provision of pastoral support and training throughout the year. The Agency also seeks to aid parishes who wish to form new groups seeking to make them a regular part of parish life.



As members of the Church we are called upon to preserve the dignity of all human life, to care for creation, and to reach out to our sisters and brothers in need. These principles are at the heart of Catholic Social Teaching and, as such, are central to our Catholic Faith.
