

## African Art

Today we will be: Exploring African sunsets.














You can really see the sun in this sunset.


















what colours can you see? What silhouettes can you see?



These steps show you how to make your own African sunset.



Paint a sun with white paint and yellow paint. Then paint yellow and orange strips across the page. Blend the paint with a dry paint brush.



Continue the above process with the red paint to the top of the page. Paint orange and red strips to the bottom of the page.



Once the paint is dry cut out a black strip of paper and glue it to the bottom of the painting.

## Remember:

Blend the paint in the sunset.

If there is white around the silhouettes you cut out, colour it in with black felt pen.
