RSHE	Life to The Full Plus
RE	To Know You More Clearly, Catholic Social Teaching, recognising and celebrating similarities and differences in other faiths
Geography	Identifying and breaking down stereotypes of people and places around the world
History	Black history, development of democracy in Europe, recognition of laws and key societal changes
Art	Diversity of artists and art from different places and backgrounds, consideration of art as an emotional outlet
Computing	E-safety curriculum
English- Reading	Exploration and engagement of books which explore character's feelings and diversity of characters
Science	Keeping healthy, life cycles and body changes
PE	Looking after ourselves, physical fitness
DT	Health and safety particularly when working with tools
Behaviour Policy	Responsibility and child's voice, consideration of positive rewards and sanctions for negative behaviour
Children's responsibility	Year 6 lunchtime buddies, school council, servers at mass
Children's voice	School council, charity work, Catholic Social Teaching, pupil surveys
