Cygnet consists of 6 core weekly information sessions where you can find out more about Autism and learn about strategies to support your child or young person. These sessions are delivered by Educational Psychologists with the support of Parent Support Advisors who work for the Enfield Advisory Service for Autism, in a supportive and confidential group. We are currently running these sessions online through Zoom and you will be sent online resources each week.
